Miriam and Michael Sirota have never been content to observe from the sidelines. They are people who step in, drawn to projects and passions that strengthen communities and bring people together, and they quickly recognized an opportunity to play a meaningful role in the renovation of the long-vacant Royal Poinciana Playhouse. In recognition of their commitment to inclusivity, **GLAZER HALL** will honor the Sirotas with a permanent plaque for the Accessibility Alcove—a space dedicated to ensuring that all members of the community feel welcomed, considered, and able to fully experience the Hall.

Together for nearly 39 years, Miriam and Michael purchased their Palm Beach residence in 2020, and the island immediately felt like home. Palm Beach reflected what they value most: a beautiful setting, a vibrant cultural life, and a close-knit community rooted in relationships rather than spectacle. It mirrors the family mantra: we fall in love with people, not things.

Miriam's commitment to community began early. She grew up in a household where civic engagement and philanthropy were part of everyday life. That example stayed with Miriam, and when their own children were young, the Sirotas became involved in schools and community charities. Giving back was never performative; it was personal.

The Sirotas believe GLAZER HALL will be a place that brings people together through intimate, accessible experiences—woven into the rhythm of daily life on the island. At its core, their story is about showing up.
